



AFSA 2017 Governing Board Election Information for Voting Members

The AFSA Committee on Elections is pleased to provide the following information regarding AFSA's 2017-2019 Governing Board election and vote on the bylaw amendments.

1. Online voting instructions will be emailed to all voting members of AFSA for whom we have a valid email address on Monday, April 17, 2017. Members should add the noreply@directvote.net to their email address books now to ensure delivery. [Click here for instructions on how to do so.](#)
2. The email with online voting instructions will contain unique voting pass code information. Do not forward the email. The subject line will read, "AFSA Ballot and Login Info."
3. For voting members without a valid email address on file, printed ballots will be mailed on Monday, April 17, 2017. Members receiving the printed ballot can either return the printed ballot or visit the online voting site to cast their votes. If both a printed ballot and an online ballot are returned from a member, only the printed ballot will be counted.
4. Retirees will receive a printed ballot in addition to the online voting instructions. Either voting method can be utilized, but only one ballot per member will be counted. If both a printed ballot and an online ballot are received, only the printed ballot will be counted.
5. Members may view a recording of the Town Hall meeting of candidates on the AFSA website at www.afsa.org/elections, or on AFSA's video page, www.afsa.org/video.
6. If you do not receive either your printed ballot or online voting instructions by May 8, please contact election@afsa.org. You will need to provide your name, address, constituency and email address.
7. Voters are reminded that they may visit the online [AFSA Community](#) to pose questions of the candidates or post comments on the AFSA [election discussion thread](#). Members will need to log in to the members-only area of the AFSA website using their primary email address and password. If you have not

logged in before, click on the "forgot password" link and an automatic "update password" link will be emailed to you.

Ballots will be counted on June 8, 2017. The results will be announced shortly thereafter. The new AFSA Governing Board will take office on July 15, 2017.
